




Application Form

We are delighted to once again deliver this incredible opportunity for our industry's apprentices. The Graduate Apprentice of the Year Award will recognise the enthusiasm, innovation and imagination of up-and-coming engineers and manufacturers.

Is there a graduate engineering apprentice in your team who has stood out and deserves recognition? Managers or supervisors are invited to submit an application on their behalf for the Scottish Engineering Graduate Apprentice of the Year Award, giving them the opportunity to be recognised for their work, and for our winner the chance to win our award trophy and £500, presented at the annual awards dinner on Thursday 14th May in Glasgow.

Criteria

- Entry is open to individuals currently enrolled in a recognised engineering and manufacturing apprenticeship
- > Entrants should be employed in the engineering industry based in Scotland.
- Those submitting an application should detail how the apprentice has stood out and/or gone above and beyond within their role and demonstrated enthusiasm, innovation and imagination throughout their programme so far
- This is an individual award unfortunately we cannot accept joint applications or group applications



Reviewing of applications

- All applications will be acknowledged via email and then reviewed by our panel of judges.
- Successful candidates (or, the "Shortlist") will be invited to an interview accompanied by their sponsor where they will make a brief presentation to discuss their experience with the judging panel

Submitting your application

- > The submission deadline is 4pm Friday 13th February 2026
- Managers/Supervisors should answer all questions outlined on the following pages, images to illustrate the answers can be submitted alongside the application
- Applications should include relevant information about the candidate and a description of why they deserve the title of Graduate Engineering Apprentice of The Year.
- > As the first round of judging will be made on this submission, it is important that you give as much information as possible within the provided form

- > Applications should be completed by Line Manager or Supervisor
